Essential Responsibilities

- Responsible for the overall strategic operation and performance of assets within the portfolio.
- Develop and manage comprehensive asset strategies including leasing, property improvements, capital structure and sell/hold analysis based upon financial, market and valuation analysis.
- Continuously review the properties for opportunities to add value through renovation, expansion or repositioning of the assets.
- Work closely with property management personnel to manage daily operations.
- Strategize with internal team to establish annual business plan for each property including operating and capital budgets.
- Establish and maintain property operation benchmarking including revenues, expenses, NOI, investment projections, return on investment, and cash flow and distribution analysis.
- Maintain a detailed understanding of factors affecting various markets and submarkets associated with portfolio and monitor market trends in value, cost and supply/demand fundamentals.
- Understand competitive positioning relative to rents, lease terms and overall occupancy.
- Maintain property specific compliance with loan documents and equity agreements.

- Oversee leasing and marketing plan for properties including lease up projections, estimated tenant improvement costs, marketing methods and prospect plans.
- Form close relationship with existing tenants and work closely with leasing teams to maximize occupancy.
- Negotiate and execute leases and perform detailed financial analysis of specific lease transactions.
- Oversee preparation of and review property and portfolio financial statements.
- Maintain ARGUS files and excel models. Continuously review, analyze and prepare detailed financial analysis of properties and portfolio including cash flow projections and financial return analysis.
- Review and prepare quarterly and annual reports on property performance, including budget variances, along with progress on strategic initiatives.
- Play an active role with acquisitions team in underwriting process and preliminary due diligence for new opportunities.
